- The total financial support available is £5,000, which will be released in phases.
- Please note that we aim to help a variety of groups and spread the funds as widely as
- possible. The maximum funding available to a single applicant is £1,500.
- Practical help/ gifts in kind are available through Love From Anwyl including the donation of
- staff time and/or materials.
- Please ensure all information you want us to consider is included in your initial application.
- Supplementary documents will not be considered at this stage, but we may request additional details about your project.
- Priority will be given to applications that benefit the community close to our development at Whittle Brook Park, Manchester Road, Heywood, OL10 2QD.
- Remember to detail how you would use the funds requested or the practical help you would like from the Anwyl team. This could be to purchase equipment, decorate, etc.
- If the total budget for your project exceeds the funding available and/or it is part of a bigger

project, please include a breakdown of costs and timescales involved. We may be able to support an element of your project alongside other local causes.

- Successful applicants will be required to take part in PR/promotional activity for the community fund.

- We aim to let you know if you have been successful within a month of application.
- Applications will be assessed by an Anwyl Homes panel who will choose how the community fund is allocated. Their decision is final.
- Successful applicants MUST participate in PR/promotional activity for the Anwyl Community Fund within 6 months of the fund being allocated.
