Final surfacing - block paving private and shared drives

The next drives due to be topped of are plots 78 - 69, these will be done by the end of September.

Trees, landscaping and street scene

Landscaping to all homes will be carried out upon legal completion of each home, along with any shrubs. With regards to trees, these will be installed on completed homes during the months of October to February which is the planting season.

Final surfacing - roads and footpaths

The final surfacing (block paving) of footpaths will be completed in line with the progress of build through the development. There are no roads that will be final surfaced in the next three months.

Local authority roads / footpath adoption

Cheshire East is the local adopting authority who will ultimately be responsible for the roads and footpaths once a 12 month maintenance period and formal adoption has taken place.

Waste water / pump station adoption

The water pumping station is live and operational. This will ultimately be adopted by United Utilities, however, there is no anticipated handover date for this at this time.
